1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “FISA Sunsets Reau-
3 thorization Act of 2011”.

8 (a) TEMPORARY EXTENSION OF PROVISIONS RELAT-

11 Improvement and Reauthorization Act of 2005 (Public
12 Law 109–177; 50 U.S.C. 1805 note, 50 U.S.C. 1861 note,
13 and 50 U.S.C. 1862 note) is amended by striking “May
14 27, 2011” and inserting
15 “DECEMBER 31, 2017”.

16 (b) PERMANENT EXTENSION OF PROVISION RELAT-
17 ING TO INDIVIDUAL TERRORISTS AS AGENTS OF FOREIGN
18 POWERS.—Section 6001 of the Intelligence Reform and
19 Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–458;
20 118 Stat. 3742; 50 U.S.C. 1801 note) is amended—

21 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “(a) IN GEN-
22 ERAL.—Section” and inserting “Section”; and

23 (2) by striking subsection (b).
